# Hindustan Power commissions 30 MW solar farm in Punjab

CHANDIGARH: The clean energy arm of Hindustan Power on Tuesday commissioned a 30 MW solar farm in Mansa district of Punjab which can help light up 24,000 homes.



The clean energy arm of the company is the largest solar farm developer in India, generating carbon savings of approx 720,000 tonnes per year.

The mid-sized, grid-connected solar farm, set up with an investment of Rs 200 crore, will tap the solar energy potential of the state—estimated at 4-7 KWH/sqmt of solar insolation levels—and enable it to achieve its renewable purchase obligation (RPO) obligation.

The project will feed 50 million units of clean energy annually to the 66 KV grid and will be enough to meet the energy needs of 24,000 households every day," Hindustan Power chairman Ratul Puri said.
