

HP commissions 1,200 MW coal-based project in MP

Hindustan Power (HP), an energy company with presence in coal-based and renewable generation, on Thursday announced that it commissioned the first phase (2,600 MW) of its flagship 2,520 MW Anuppur thermal power project in Madhya Pradesh at a cost of ₹8,000 crore. The second unit of the project commissioned on March 30 this year. While the firm has power purchase agreements (PPAs) with Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh for 420 MW and 361 MW respectively, it sells the remaining capacity in the spot market.
