

Hindustan Power's arm commissions solar farm

The clean energy arm of Hindustan Power on Tuesday said that it has commissioned 30 MW solar farm in Punjab. The firm made an investment of ₹200 crore for the mid-sized grid connected solar farm. The project will feed 50 million units of clean energy annually to the 66 KV grid, which will be enough to cater to the energy needs of 24,000 households per day. The farm will tap the vast solar energy potential of Punjab estimated at 4-7 KWH/Sq.mtr of solar insolation levels to promote clean energy and will enable the state to achieve its RPO obligation, the company said.
